

Access Statement For Craster Pine Lodges

Introduction

Our two 4 star self-catering lodges are situated on a private site in Craster Village some 200metres from the harbour. Both lodges provide accommodation on one level. The Moorings lodge sleeps 6 persons in a double, twin and adult size bunk bed rooms and is graded Category 2 in The National Accessible Scheme. The Anchorage lodge sleeps 4 in a double and twin bed room. Both lodges are all electric.

We have tried to provide as much information as possible in this statement. If you have any queries please do contact us. Printed copies of this access statement are available. We look forward to welcoming you.

Pre-Arrival

- We have our own website which gives details of facilities, availability and charges.
- Enquiries can be made via e-mail or phone.
- The village has a bus service to Alnwick, Berwick-Upon-Tweed and Newcastle.
- The nearest train station is at Alnmouth 7 miles away. The Nearest airport is at Newcastle. We can provide car rental service details.
- We can arrange for basic provisions to be available for your arrival.

Arrival & Car Parking Facilities

- There is a car park space in front of each lodge with additional space nearby on site.
- Car park areas are level and provide rear access to vehicle once parked.
- The Moorings lodge has a permanent ramp access with handrails to the veranda from which there is a double door access to the lodge. There is also a side door access from the veranda.
- The Anchorage lodge has 3 steps with handrails up to the veranda and access door.
- Each lodge is clearly identified with a pictorial name sign,
- There is a contact telephone number clearly displayed on the rear exterior of the Moorings Lodge.
- There is a public phone box 200metres away in the harbour area. At present few mobile phone services work in the village.
- Each lodge has an external sensory light for access during the hours of darkness.
- Dogs are welcome and dog bowls are provided.

Public Areas - General (Internal)

- Smoke alarms are fitted in the corridor between the open plan area and the bedrooms.
- The Moorings has two 3 seater sofas in the lounge area. The dining table for 6 has moveable padded seat chairs with no arms. There is a further chair in the bedroom with arms if needed.
- Both lodges have teletext TV with Freeview and remote control. Also provided are DVD, Video and music systems for CD, radio and tapes.
- A cot and high chair can be provided.
- Our brochures show the internal layout of facilities in each lodge.
- There are good public dog walking facilities very close by.

Laundry

- Each lodge has a standard size washer/dryer, which is front loading, provided in the kitchen area. There are also external drying facilities in the garden.

Outdoor Facilities

- The Moorings has an enclosed garden area with brick built barbeque, picnic table, wooden seat and small lawned area all on the one level.
- The Anchorage has a private area with picnic table and mobile barbeque.
- Both lodges have bird feeding stations alongside which are easily viewed from the inside of the lodges.

Bedrooms

- Moorings. 1 Double bedroom and 1 twin bedroom accessible to wheelchairs. Third bedroom adult size bunk beds at right angles to each other.
- Anchorage. 1 Double and 1 twin bedroom.

Bathroom, Shower-room & WC [Ensuite or Shared]

- THE MOORINGS.

- Sliding door, non slip flooring, unobstructed clear floor space.
- Level entry walk in shower (no bath). Shower seat and horizontal hand rail.
- Wash hand basin has lever taps, thermostatically controlled water & vertical hand rail alongside.
- Toilet seat has horizontal handrails either side.
- ANCHORAGE has step in shower. No bath.

Self-Catering Kitchen

- Both lodges access into the open plan lounge, kitchen and dining area.
- The kitchen areas have linoleum flooring with short pile carpeting throughout the rest of the open plan area, corridor and bedrooms.
- The Moorings Lodge kitchen provides National Accessibility Scheme Category 2 facilities. It has a fridge freezer. The Anchorage has a small fridge with freezer compartment.
- Both lodges have a 4 ring electric hob with a drop down oven door which can be accessed from the side. Microwave ovens are also provided.
- Both fully fitted with crockery, pots, pans, cutlery and glassware.
